



### **SPECIAL PERMISSION GUIDELINES**

The O.A.S.A Registrar must receive a request for Special Permission no later than June 1<sup>st</sup> of the current year. Use the Special Permission Form.

It must include the following:

1. A written request signed by the player or players involved, and
2. A release from the player's or players' home team or association, if required by the rules. Use the Player Release Form.

If the above requirements are met the following re-classification applies to the team receiving the player or players:

- A. One player from a classification one higher than the normal classification – no change.
- B. One player from a classification two higher than the normal classification – re-classified one higher.
- C. One player from a classification three higher than the normal classification – re-classified two higher.
- D. One player from a classification four higher than the normal classification – re-classified three higher.
- E. More than one player from a classification higher than the normal classification – re-classified to the highest classification level of the players involved.
